Four African countries face devastating famine. "The situation is dire," reported Al Goff, president and CEO of Global Aid Network (GAiN), who recently was in South Sudan. This food crisis, the largest in 70 years, affects 20 million people. According to the United Nations, if no action is taken an additional 10 million will be threatened. GAiN is sending the first wave of relief in the form of nine huge containers filled with food, water filters, and medical supplies into these countries in Jesus' name.
